



Restrictions on natural gas in single family homes should be resisted as impractical, uneconomical and simply dangerous to the health and well being of homeowners.

WHAT CAN YOU DO? MAKE YOUR VOICE HEARD!

Ordinances trying to ban Natural Gas are all local and enforced by the local building departments. At its core, the ban takes away choice. You, your builder, or contractor should interact with the building department and **resist any restriction on "single family" projects.** You and your builder should **contact the city manager** directly as well to **contest any limits on natural gas** access on single family dwellings.

Some cities are already being sued for unnecessary restrictions on gas used in restaurants. It is dangerous to the safety and security of homeowners if natural gas is restricted and the electric utility decides to shut off the power grid or if there are technical complications such as an earthquake or other natural disaster. **No heat, no light, no phone, no car charging, no air-conditioning, no cooking!**
